EAGLEBANK BOWL ANNOUNCES FEDERAL NEWS RADIO 1500 AM
AS LOCAL RADIO BROADCAST PARTNER

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The EagleBank Bowl announced today that Federal News Radio 1500 AM will serve as the local radio broadcast partner airing this year’s game to be held Tuesday, December 29th in Washington, D.C.’s RFK Stadium. The game will also be broadcast live on ESPN starting at 4:30 p.m.

Federal News Radio 1500 AM will broadcast the game in its entirety including a 30-minute pre-game show, a 30-minute post-game wrap up show and a simultaneous streaming broadcast on FederalNewsRadio.com.

This year’s matchup features the first-ever meeting between the Temple Owls and the UCLA Bruins. Both Rick Neuheisel at UCLA and Al Golden at Temple have guided the resurgence of their respective programs with talented coaching staffs and players.
