WCSA ANNOUNCES INCREASED ACCESS TO RFK STADIUM PARKING LOT 8

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The [Washington Convention and Sports Authority](#) (WCSA) announced today that the repaving of RFK Stadium Parking Lot 8 is proceeding on schedule and an additional 500 parking spaces will be available for all events starting with the D.C. United vs. Colorado Rapids game Saturday. In addition, the Independence Avenue entrance to Lot 8 is now open.

RFK Stadium Parking Lot 8 was damaged due to the blizzards of 2010.

“The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) and the Department of Public Works (DPW) have worked diligently to restore the lot as soon as possible so we are pleased with the progress on the project to date,” said Erik A. Moses, managing director of the WCSA’s Sports, Entertainment and Special Events Division. “The additional space will be made available to D.C. United fans immediately. We anticipate the remainder of the lot will be available before the end of the month.”

All other RFK Stadium parking lots and the Access Road remain fully accessible.
