## **RFK STADIUM TO HOST 3<sup>RD</sup> ANNUAL “TRUCK TOUCH” JUNE 12**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The [Washington Convention and Sports Authority](#) (WCSA) and the [DC Department of Public Works](#) (DPW) invite the public to the city’s third annual citywide “**Truck Touch**” event Saturday, June 12 from 9 a.m. - 2 p.m. on RFK Stadium Lot 7. A host of DC government agencies will present more than 20 vehicles used to provide vital city services for viewing and exploration. **This event is FREE to the general public.**

“Truck Touch” will feature vehicles from the DC Departments of Public Works, Transportation, Health, Employment Services, Parks and Recreation, Fire and Emergency Medical Services, Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency, the Metropolitan Police Department and the DC Water and Sewer Authority. Information on various government services will also be available.

**VEHICLES ON DISPLAY:** Fire and dump trucks, a police helicopter, a fire and lab truck, heavy and light plows; a knuckle boom truck, electric and compressed natural gas vehicles, a wrecker, a front end loader, a bucket truck, Red Cross frontline response vehicles and a one-stop mobile health and employment van.

RFK Stadium is easily accessible by the Metro on the Blue and Orange lines (Stadium-Armory station) and numerous bus lines. Secured parking is also available.
